---

I am a security professional with a diverse set of skills. I am an experienced police officer, personal protection officer (PPO), and police trainer. I have instructed members of emergency response teams and other tactical groups in the United States and overseas. I have extensive operational planning experience, having planned and carried out missions in support of paramilitary police units in Iraq and Afghanistan. In addition, I have conducted a comprehensive array of criminal and traffic investigations.

Since April of 2005, I have worked in non-permissive hostile environments as a trainer, advisor, and operator. Most recently I was the training manager for convoy escort teams (CET) and personal security details (PSD) in Iraq. This included instructing expatriate and local national employees in all facets of convoy operations, small unit tactics, and firearms training.

I was one of the first four mentors selected to assist in the formation of the Afghan National Civil Order Police (ANCOP). ANCOP is responsible for providing a robust police presence in the high threat contested areas of Afghanistan and is a paramilitary counter insurgency police entity. For 17 months I trained ANCOP personnel and mentored them in the field.

Prior to my deployment to Afghanistan, I worked for 19 months in Iraq; six months as a member of a PSD, and 13 months as a trainer for the Special Police Commandos and the Public Order Battalions. These two policing groups are Iraq's paramilitary policing unit responsible for combating civil unrest and insurgent activities.

I am a reliable self-starter and present professional image. I communicate well and have a good grasp of all common Microsoft Office programs. I have been in several leadership positions as an instructor, a police officer, a US Marine, and as a security professional in both Iraq and Afghanistan. I make timely and sound tactical decisions and work well with teammates.
